LAUNCH RAMP, PARKING FACILITY AND BOAT-IN CAMPGROUND

## LAKE CLEMENTINE FACILITIES TEMPORARILY CLOSED THIS WEEKEND

AUBURN – The Lake Clementine entrance road, launch ramp, and parking facility at Lake Clementine in the Auburn State Recreation Area will be temporarily closed to public use this weekend, California State Parks officials announced today.

The Lake Clementine entrance road, launch ramp, and parking facility will be closed to the public from 6:00 AM to 12:00 PM on May 31, 2003. In addition, the upper boat parking area will be closed to the public from 10:00 AM May 30, 2003 to 12:00 PM May 31, 2003. The public will be able to still access the lower parking area, boat ramp and lake during this time.

Lake Clementine is the site of the World's Toughest Half Triathlon sponsored by Bradventures of Auburn. Triathlon begins with a swim in Lake Clementine, continues with a bike race along Foresthill Road into Foresthill, down Mosquito Ridge Road and back on the same route to the Auburn Overlook. The final leg is a run down Western States Trail to the Olmstead Loop and back to the Auburn Overlook via the Auburn To Cool Trail. The Lake Clementine road and facilities will reopen to the public upon completion of the swimming portion of the event.
